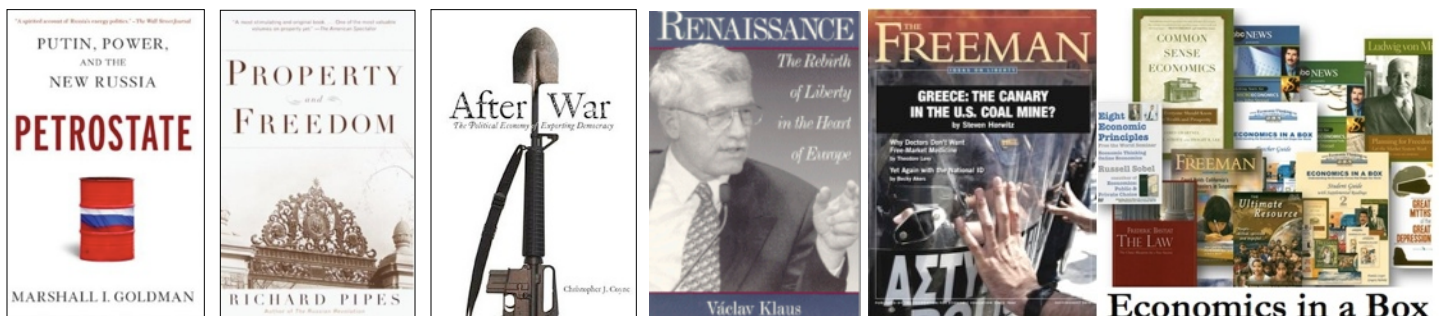
Presentations will also discuss government legitimacy, popular sovereignty and protecting rights. This workshop will appeal to a wide audience of students interested in public policy and world affairs.
